

Bangkok police has High IQ

Police reinforced with iOmniscient's system

On August 17th 2015 Bangkok was devastated by two bombs that were set off at the Erwan Shrine near the Hyatt Hotel in the city - a very crowded area. Twenty innocent people were killed and 125 were injured. The Royal Thai police have swung into action to catch the culprits involved. In parallel, they have decided to upgrade their existing systems by implementing a state-of-the-art Face recognition system from iOmniscient.



The Royal Thai police had an Oracle database system of Faces of people of interest. The iOmniscient Face Recognition system was the first step in automating the use of that system. They wanted the most advanced system available in the market to support their policing efforts.
